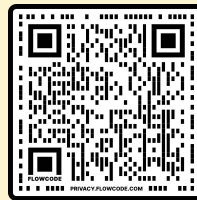

## Income Guidelines

If your income is below these guidelines you may be eligible for assistance. Income guidelines can change from year to year.

### What You Need to Do to Get Help

Call, write or go to our website for an application.

Send copies of income for three months prior to application signature date or provide us with a copy of last year's federal tax return if you are self-employed.

Send us one copy of your utility bills.
