ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCE OF
THE VILLAGE OF DENNISON, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Dennison does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinances Repealed: The following ordinances of the Village of Dennison are hereby wholly repealed:

Ordinance numbered 1 through 4 dated February 24, 1905, and entitled:

Ordinance No. 1. An ordinance establishing by-laws of the Village Council.

Ordinance No. 2. An ordinance prescribing duties of the Village Marshall.

Ordinance No. 3. An ordinance relating to vagrants, disorderly houses, gambling, disturbing schools or religious meetings, disorderly or indecent conduct and indecent exposures, drunkenness, fast driving, resisting officers, discharging firearms, hitching horses and animals injury to property, disturbing the peace, assault and battery and driving on sidewalks.

Ordinance No. 4. An ordinance relating to building and repairing sidewalks in the Village of Dennison.

Ordinance No. 5. An ordinance relating to a fire limit, fire warden, and construction of inflammable building, passed March 4, 1910.

Ordinance No. 6. An ordinance granted to Standard Oil Co. passed April 20, 1914.

Ordinance No. 13. An ordinance regulating curfew for the Village of Dennison, passed December 18, 1928.

Ordinance No. 16. An ordinance entitled Electric Franchise, passed March 7, 1933.

Ordinance No. 18. An ordinance entitled an amendment to ordinance No. 17, passed May 1, 1934.

Ordinance Numbered 19, 20, 21.

Ordinance No. 26.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. Passed by the Dennison Village Council this 6 day of June, 1960.
