ORDINANCE NO. 64

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING NUDITY IN LICENSED LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENTS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENNISON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and general welfare of the people of the City of Dennison that certain types of activities, as set forth in this ordinance are prohibited upon the premises of licensed liquor, wine, and beer establishments so as to best protect and assist the owners and operators and employees of these premises, as well as patrons and the public in general.

Further, that the City does ordain that the standards in this ordinance reflect the prevailing community standards in the City of Dennison. This ordinance is intended to prevent harm stemming from the physical immediacy and combination of alcohol, nudity, and sex. We also desire to prevent any subliminal endorsement of sexual harassment or activities likely to lead to the possibility of various criminal conduct such as prostitution, sexual assault, and disorderly conduct.

SECTION 2. Certain acts prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any licensee to permit or allow any person or persons from being upon the licensed premises when such person does not have his or her buttocks, anus, breast, and genitals covered with a non-transparent material.

SECTION 3. Violation. A violation of this ordinance is a misdemeanor, and is justification for revocation or suspension of any liquor, wine, or beer license.

SECTION 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication according to law.
